The Carroll County Board of Supervisors, Carroll County Industrial Development Authority, and Carroll County Public Service Authority held a Special Joint Meeting on Wednesday, December 17, 2008 in the Board Meeting Room of the Carroll County Governmental Center.

At 2:00 p.m., Mr. Dickson called the Board of Supervisors to Order, Mr. Hurst called the Public Service Authority to Order, and Mr. Slate called the Industrial Development Authority to Order.

Mr. Newman explained that the revenue projected for the Exit 19 Sewer Project and for the Long Range Water Project would not be sufficient to cover the monthly loan payments and that Rural Development required showing a revenue stream that would cover the payments. He presented a draft agreement between the Industrial Development Authority and the Public Service Authority whereby the Public Service Authority would make water and sewer service available at Exit 19 and the Industrial Development Authority would make monthly payments to the Public Service Authority for this availability. He explained that the numbers in the draft agreement were subject to change based on the bids received for the project and told that Rural Development would use this agreement as collateral toward the loan.
