**IN RE: PAYMENT PLAN GUIDELINES FOR COST AND RESTITUTION IN
CRIMINAL MATTERS**

ORDER

CM 15-500-18

It is hereby ORDERED that deferred payments for fines and costs imposed in the Circuit Court of Carroll County will be accepted per the following guidelines.

The defendant shall be required to submit a petition for installments or deferred payments to the Carroll County Circuit Court Clerk's Office. Defendants on supervised probation may submit the petition through their probation officer.

For costs and restitution in the amount of \$0 to \$1,500 the defendant shall be required to pay no less than \$50.00 per month; for costs and restitution in the amount of \$1,501 to \$3,000 the defendant shall be required to pay no less than \$100.00 per month; for costs and restitution above \$3,000 defendant shall be required to pay no less than \$125.00 per month or at an amount to be set at the discretion of the Clerk or Court. All payments will be applied to restitution first.

Payments under the plan shall be due on the first or 15th of the month, with the first payment due the month immediately following the month in which the application was made.

Methods of payment include cash, checks, money orders, credit card, debit card or prepaid card (any type of card will have a 4% fee added to payment). Checks or money order shall be made payable to the Clerk of Circuit Court. Payments must include the case number and a self-address, stamped envelope for return of a receipt.

Default on agreements will require the defendant to complete a new petition for installment or deferred payment, subject to the approval of the Court.
