

CARROLL COUNTY CPMT

Minutes

January 21, 2014

The Carroll County Community Policy & Management Team met on January 21, 2014 at the Carroll County Department of Social Services in Hillsville. Members present for the meeting included: Mike Jennings (DSS; Chair), Laura Goad (Carroll County Public Schools), Doug Garvey for Rob Hiatt (27<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court, CSU), Vicky Richardson (Carroll County Health Dept), Gary Larowe (County Administrator), Laura Davis (Mt. Rogers CSB). Absent: Trent Staton (FPS) and Heather Shockley (parent representative).

Patricia Draughan, FAPT representative and Jackie Roberts, CSA Coordinator, attended.

Mr. Jennings called the meeting to order at 9:02 a. m.

Motion was made by Ms. Richardson and seconded by Mr. Jennings to approve the minutes for the December 16, 2013 meeting. The minutes were approved.

Upon motion by Mr. Garvey, seconded by Mr. Larowe, the CPMT accepted the current fund balance and reimbursement requests.

Mr. Jennings, seconded by Mr. Larowe, stated: "Pursuant to Section 2.2-3711 (A) Code of Virginia, I move that the Carroll County Community Policy and Management Team convene a closed meeting for the purpose of discussion with the Family Assessment and Planning Team representative regarding case presentations exempted from open session, as authorized by Section 2.2-3711 (A) (1) of the Code of Virginia." This was approved by vote: Ayes: 5 Nays: 0 at 9:07 a.m.

Patricia Draughan presented recommendations of the January 9, 2014 FAPT meeting.

Laura Davis entered at 9:08 a. m.

Mr. Jennings made a motion to return to open session. Mr. Jennings read: "I move that a certification be approved stating the Carroll County Community Policy and Management Team while in closed session discussed only public business matters lawfully exempted from the open meeting requirements as stated in Virginia Law and that only such public matters as were identified in the motion convening the closed meeting were heard, discussed, or considered." This motion was seconded by Mr. Larowe and approved by vote: Ayes: 6 Nays: 0 at 9:30 a. m.

Upon motion by Mr. Jennings with second by Mr. Larowe, the CPMT approved all cases as presented with the following notations: case #1 is non-mandated and case #5 was denied by FAPT.

Mr. Jennings shared from the OCS that public comment is open on a policy change related to purchase of foster care services. He also reviewed the CSA progress report.

The CPMT discussed and completed the Critical Services Gap Survey. The top five prioritized needs were: Intensive Substance Abuse Services, Psychological Assessment, Medication Follow-up/Psychiatric Review, Crisis Intervention and Stabilization, and Transportation.

Mr. Jennings has contacted Dr. Miller (former CPMT member) and he is willing to be a resource for the community assessment. The community assessment work group appointed was: Mike Jennings, Jackie Roberts, Ale Silva (CCPS), Patricia Draughan (DSS), Laura Davis or Mt. Rogers CSB designee, and Gary Larowe or county administration designee.

The next meeting will be on Tuesday, February 18, 2014 at 9 a.m.
